As the texts will undergo a peer review process, submission will take place in two phases:

In the second phase, you will incorporate the revisions required in accordance with the reviewers' comments and resubmit your texts.

Important notes:

- Texts that do not follow the template will be returned to their authors for the necessary corrections.
- Texts are accepted in both Greek and English.
- Linguistic editing and the accuracy of the content presented in the texts remain the sole responsibility of the authors.
- Late submissions will not be included in the volume of proceedings.
- Texts must be submitted exclusively in doc or docx format.
- The length of texts must not exceed 10,000 words (including abstracts, references, and any appendices).
- As the file name, you must use the code of your paper as indicated at the beginning of this message.
- No extension will be granted.
